User Manual

1. Introduction

This user manual provides instructions for setting up the PayU payment integration by copying a PayU India folder into the system and configuring it as per the need. By following these steps, you can quickly integrate the payment functionality into your platform.

2. Pre-requisites

Before you begin the setup process, ensure that you have the following prerequisites.

- Access the third-party PayU payment integration folder.
- Users will be provided GitHub links.
- Knowledge of the configuration settings required for the integration.
- WooCommerce version supported is less than or equal to 8.2.2

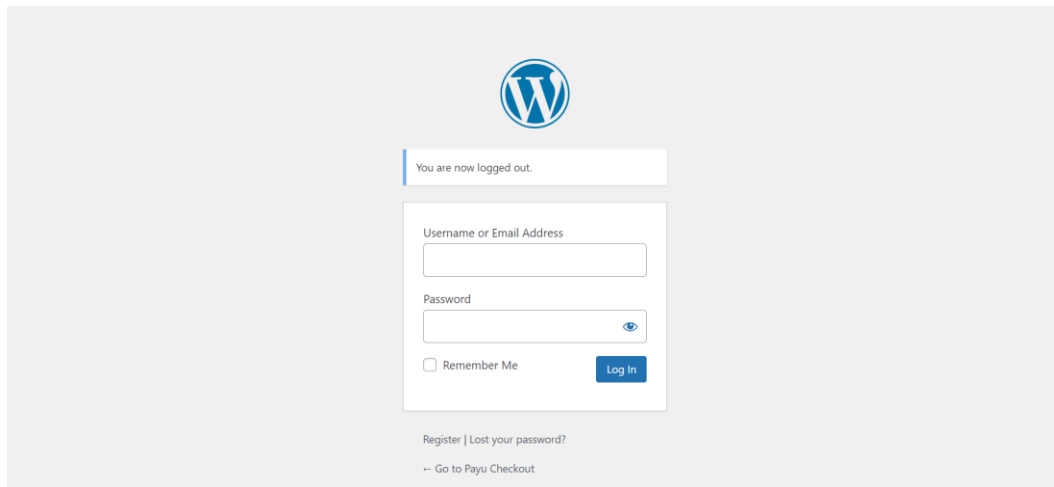
3. Setup Steps

Follow these steps to set up the third-party payment integration in WooCommerce website.

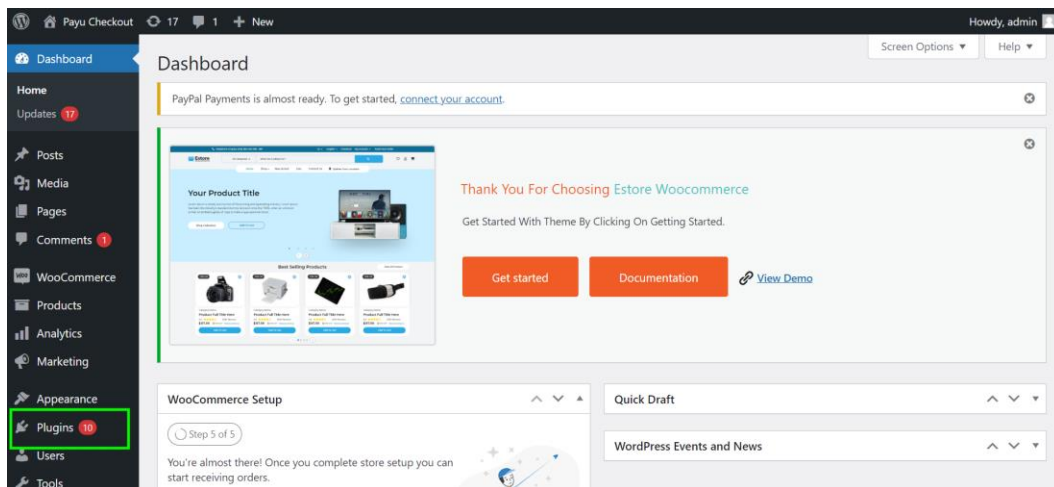
- **Obtain Integration Folder**

Obtain the PayU India folder provided by the third-party payment service provider. This folder contains all the necessary files and configurations required for the integration.

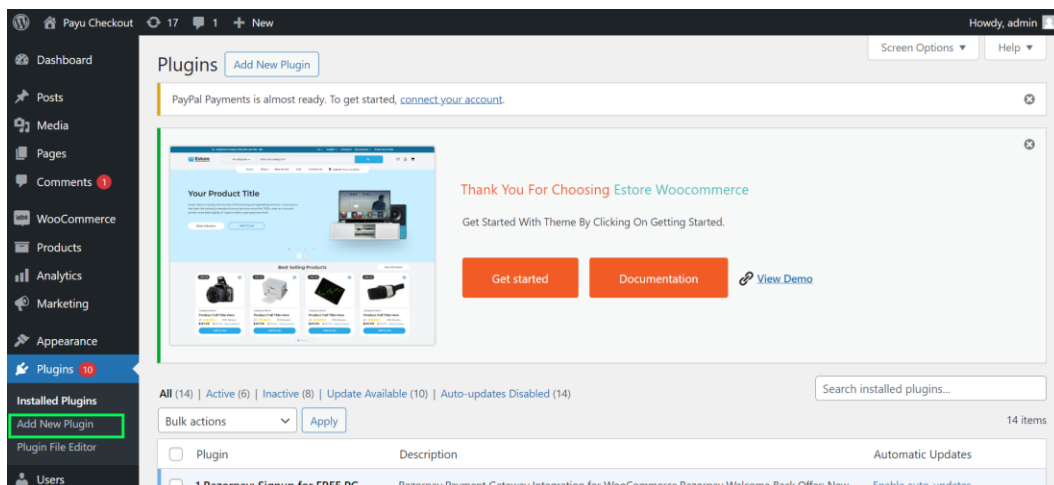
- **Login to PayU dashboard**



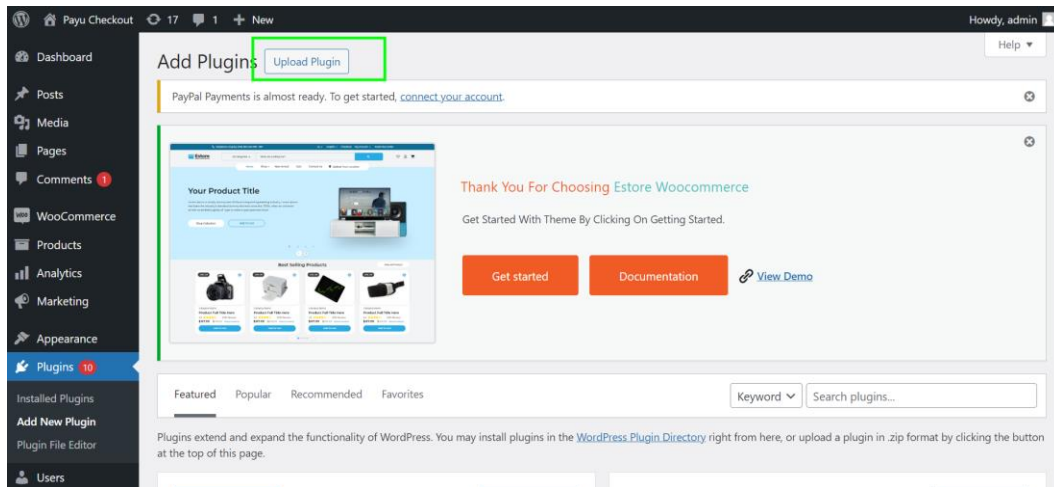
- **Click on Plugin**



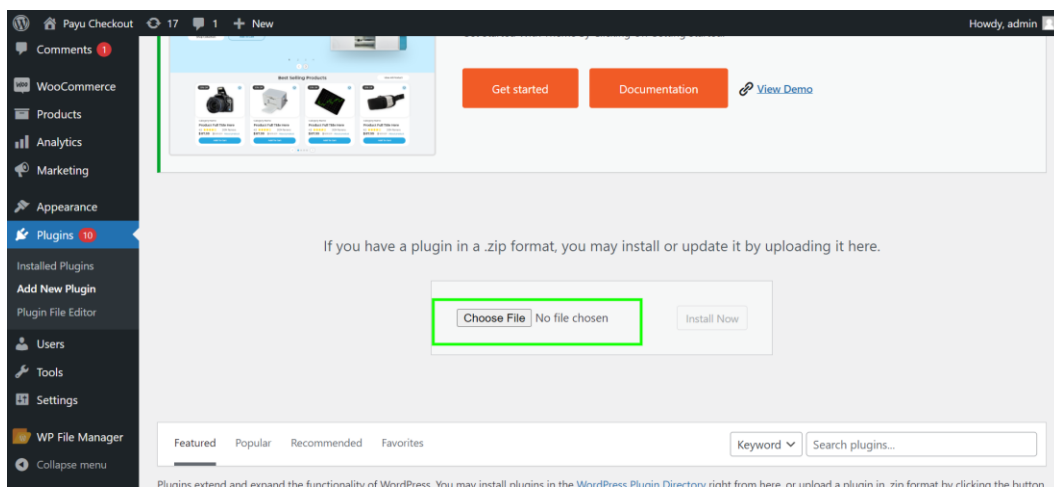
- **Click on Add New Plugin**



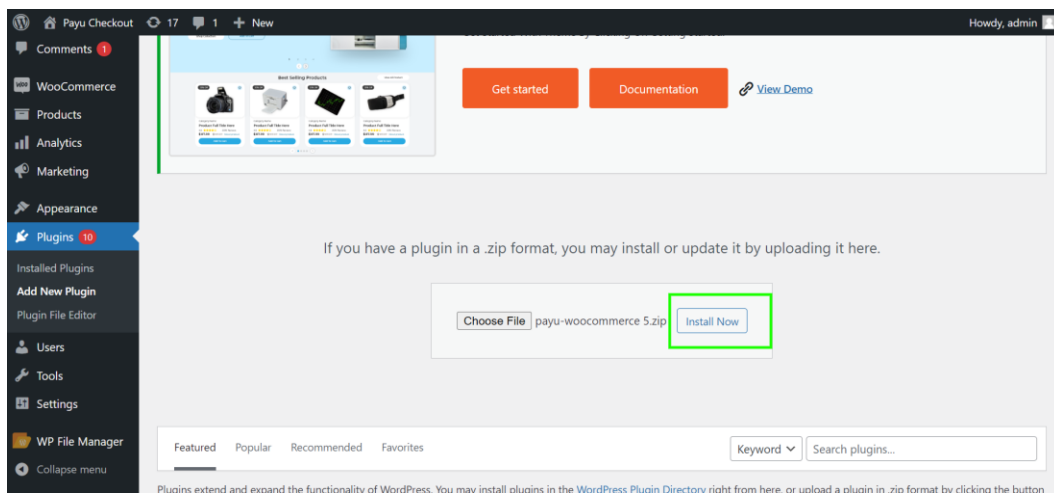
- Click on Upload Plugin



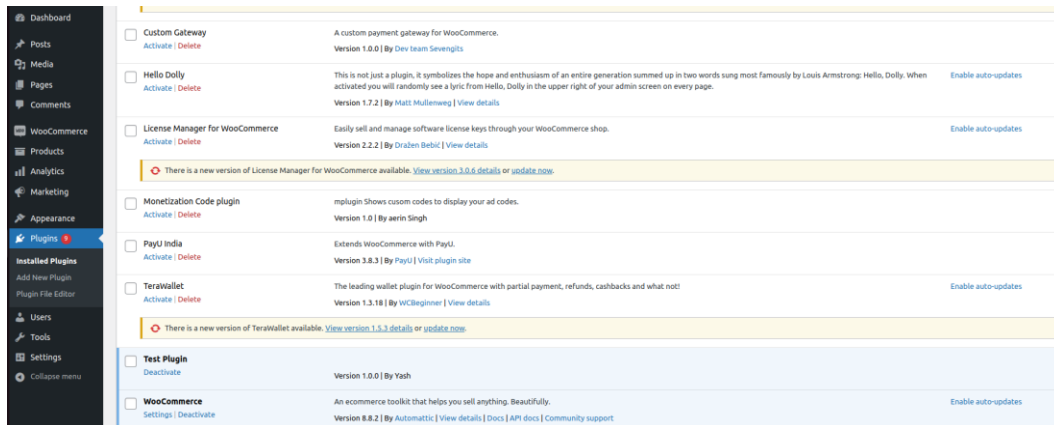
- Click on Choose File to upload from your system



- Click on Install Now

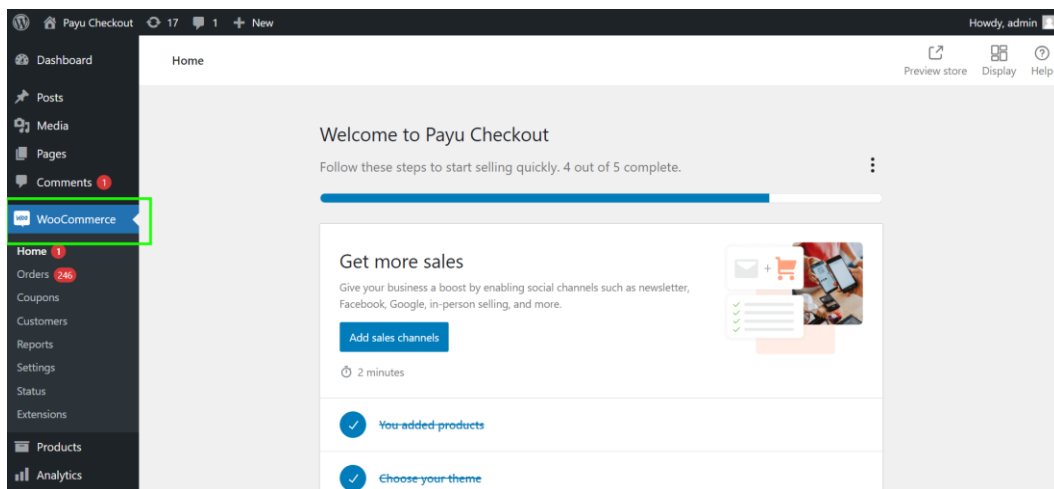
